



Idaho Conservation Corps – AmeriCorps Conservation Intern Payette National Forest –McCall Ranger District McCall, Idaho

Position Title: Biological Technician (Wildlife) – 450 HR

Position Summary:

The Payette National Forest is recruiting one Biological Technician (Wildlife) summer from May 29th through August 17th 2018. The incumbent will be paired with a Forest Service Employee to complete surveys for wildlife species. This position will typically work four ten hour days per week (Monday through Thurs).

Duties and Responsibilities:

The intern will primarily complete surveys for wildlife species, with a focus on bat monitoring, to support restoration work on the Forest.

Required Qualifications:

- Willingness to work as part of a small team
- Current driver's license.
- Good written and verbal communication skills.
- Positive attitude
- Ability to lift and carry up to 30lbs
- Ability to work outdoors in remote settings and inclement weather on uneven ground
- Intern may travel to other duty stations during the work week and remain over-night occasionally

Desired Qualifications:

- Experience reading maps and attention to detail
- Previous experience using GPS units and other mobile devices
- Coursework in biology or related field
- Strong interest in resource management.

Duty/Housing Location:

Duties are performed out of the McCall Ranger District McCall, Idaho. Housing is not provided.

Terms of Employment:

One AmeriCorps member will complete a term of service (length dependent on commitment of hours), starting May 29th through August 17th 2018. The member must complete a minimum of 450 service hours by the end of their term.

Program Benefits:

\$3,125 living allowance, prorated on a pay period (monthly) basis, a \$1,527.45 education award upon completion of the 450 hours of service. The incumbent will receive training in CPR/First Aid & defensive driving.

The living allowance and education award are taxable. Members are responsible for providing their own food. Service eligibility is contingent upon the results of a criminal and driving background check.

The member will not engage in any prohibited activities as stated in the Member Service Agreement.
